Endoluminal Treatment of recurrent Varicose Veins

Recurrent varicose vein cases do require special techniques to be treated in an endoluminal approach.

A combination of techniques such as radial laser and steam and sclerotherapy allows to treat any case of recurrent varicose veins but does need a scrupulous pre-operative ultrasound scan and mapping especially looking for insufficient perforators and accessories of GSV and SSV, the Thigh Extension of the SSV and suprainguinal and pelvic sources of reflux.
