- radiofrequency ablation (RFA)
- glue (VENASEAL®)
- steam injection
- sclerotherapy and foam sclerotherapy

None of these methods is appropriate to cure all different types of varicose veins, such as stem veins, perforator veins, recurrent veins, thread veins and spider veins and side branches.

Especially patients coming from abroad to get their varicose veins done, will not accept the inconvenience of several appointments e.g. for first stem veins, then to undergo mini phlebectomy to get rid of side branches and finally get a third appointment to treat spiders by laser or sclerotherapy.

If different techniques are being combined in one single session, any bothering varicose veins on one or both legs can be treated and no further appointments are needed, as well as the patient normally is able to fly back after only a day.

We are demonstrating how to combine the up-to-date treatment options to one single tailor made surgical procedure in a safe and effective way.
